

Where Benefits Ranked




Respondents tended to have the more traditional benefits such as bonuses, car or car allowance and pensions.

The selection of benefits available to be ranked was chosen through an earlier pilot study – surprisingly very few respondents were interested in either flexible working or holiday levels.


Bonuses

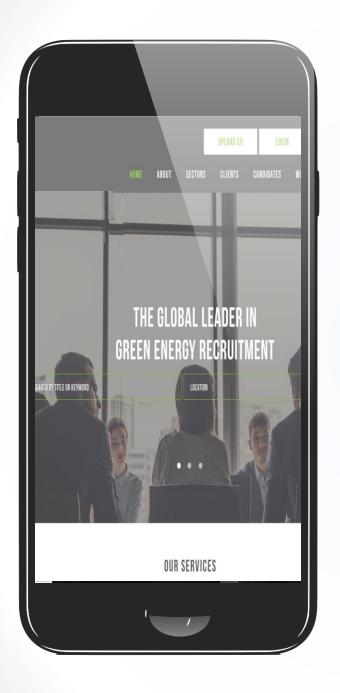
- The mean bonus was £10,481

- The mode bonus was £5,000
- The largest bonuses were in sales focused roles where bonus values could exceed 100% of basic salary. Outside of these roles, bonuses typically ranged up to 50% of basic salary.
