SILVERSTONE MOTOGP: DOVIZIOSO AND QUARTARARO HOSPITALISED FOLLOWING SHOCKING CRASH

Andrea Dovizioso and Fabio Quartararo both escaped fatal injury after being hospitalised following their horrid Lap 1 crash at Silverstone.

The race was memorable for the last-gasp finish between Alex Rins and Marc Marquez, but sadly the race will be remembered for the crash between Quartararo and Dovizioso at the high speed Copse corner.

Quartararo highsided exiting the first corner of the race, Dovizioso had not time to avoid the collision which sent the Ducati rider flying off Quartararo's Yamaha and landing heavily in the run-off area.

While Dovizioso was conscious following the collision, the 33-year-old was airlifted to hospital in Coventry with what Ducati reported as "a momentary loss of memory". It was later confirmed a head scan didn't "show any damage" for Dovizioso.

Quartararo was also hospitalised after feeling dizzy, but was later released.







ALEX ALBON REPORTS FOR RED BULL DUTIES

Alex Albon arrived at Red Bull Racing last Thursday, ready to start a new chapter of his young career with the Milton Keynes-based outfit. After the small amount of 12 Grands Prix, the 23-year-old has transferred from Faenza to Milton Keynes following an intra-team swap with Pierre Gasly between Red Bull and Toro Rosso.

A year ago at Spa, Toro Rosso boss Franz Tost was questioned on the possibility of Albon - a front-runner in F2 back then with DAMS - getting on to Helmut Marko's short list of potential drivers for 2019. The Austrian disagreed with the possibility.






2021 F1 CONCEPT CAR REVEALED

Formula 1's 2021 concept car has gone through its first windtunnel tests, and according to the series chiefs results of changes designed to improve the spectacle were "excellent".

In conjunction with the FIA, FI's in-house technical team created an initial concept ahead of the planned overhaul of the technical regulations for the 2021 season.

The CFD tests, according to the FIA's head of single-seater technical matters Nikolas Tombazis, showed the 2021 concept sustained a downforce reduction of "5-10%" when in the wake of another car compared to the 45% that current cars receive.



JESSI COMBS KILLED IN HIGH SPEED CRASH

US race car driver and television personality Jessi Combs has been killed in a crash while attempting to set a new land speed record.

The 39 year old was regarded as 'the fastest woman on four wheels'.

Paramedics responded to a call at 4p.m. on Tuesday, about 90 miles south of the city of Burns. The caller reported that a jet-powered car had crashed. The emergency services pronounced Combs dead at the scene.

Her teammate Terry Madden made the following statement via social media "Unfortunately we lost her yesterday in a horrific accident, I was the first one there and trust me we did everything humanly possible to save her," he said in an Instagram post on Wednesday.
