We will take reasonable steps to identify potential risks and ensure the integrity of our supply chain, however, we recognise that we do not control the conduct of individual and organisations in our supply chain. Ambition does, however, expect our clients, contractors, suppliers and other business partners to equally commitment to the prevention of Modern Slavery & Human Trafficking.

Process

All candidates are subject to strict compliance checks. We commit to checking the identity and eligibility to work in Australia for all of our candidates. Our due diligence checks ensure that Ambition is compliant with all relevant legislation and we continue to review our processes to ensure compliance is maintained. Ambition also encourages employees to report any suspicious activity or circumstances to the Modern Slavery Helpline on 1800 009 623.
